formulated guidelines for the further tasks related to ensuring the sustainability of project outputs.



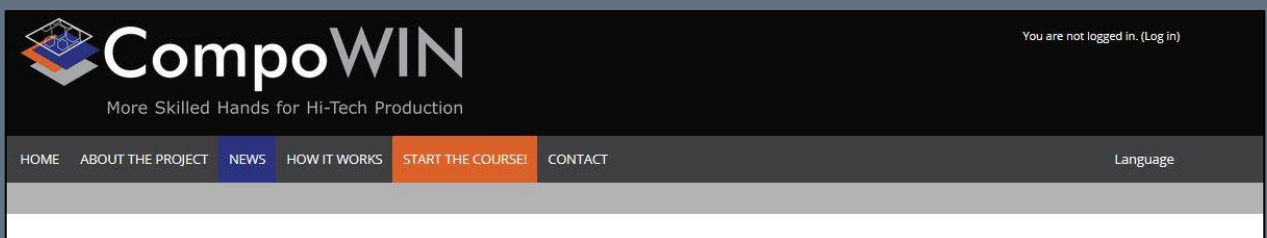
The meeting marked the conclusion of the project implementation, which resulted in various important outputs and activities aimed at supporting the uptake and further development of the composite industry in partner countries.

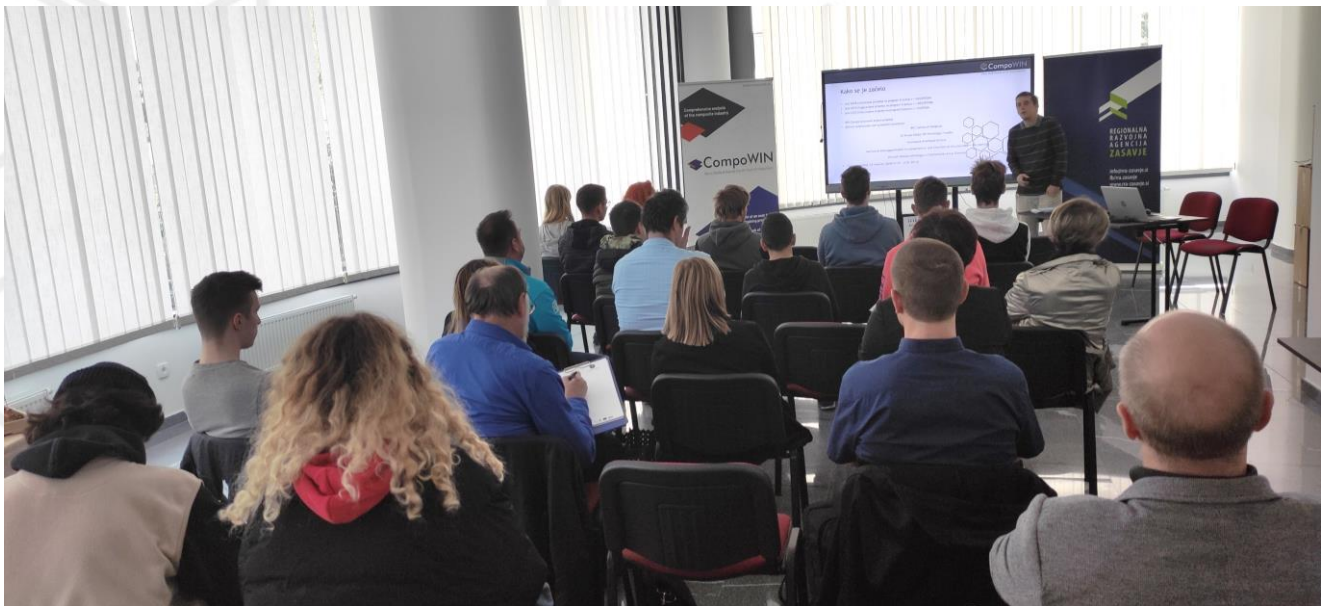
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## THE RESULTS
